H.R. 547—Amendments to the Advanced Fuels Infrastructure Research and Development Act, **Part III**

1. Roskam (R-IL). Note: This amendment passed by voice vote. Would amend the \$10 million authorization for the creation of three new programs, to require that the funding “to be derived from amounts otherwise appropriated to the Environmental Protection Agency for energy research, development, and demonstration projects and environmental research and development related to fuels.”

2. Cantor (R-VA). Inserts the following language into the bill:
“The Congress also finds that in order to lessen United States dependence on foreign sources of petroleum, and decrease demand for petroleum in aircraft, such as passenger planes with 42 business class seats capable of transcontinental flights, the nation must diversify its fuel supply for aircraft to include domestically produced alternative fuels.”

3. Rogers (R-MI). Adds the following as one of the issues to be addressed by the new biofuel infrastructure program: “issues with respect to where in the fuel supply chain additives optimally should be added to fuels.”
