Amendments to H.R. 1385—Thomasina E. Jordan Indian Tribes of Virginia Federal Recognition Act

H.R. 1385 is scheduled to be considered on the House floor on Wednesday, June 3, 2009, subject to a rule ([H.Res.490](#)). The resolution makes H.R. 1385 subject to a closed rule and H.R. 1385 subject to a structured rule making in order the following two amendments. H.Res.490 waives all points of order against consideration of the bill, except for clause 9 (earmarks) and clause 10 (“pay-go” violations) of rule XXI. The rule allows one hour of debate and provides one motion to recommit with or without instructions for each separate bill.

AMENDMENTS MADE IN ORDER UNDER THE RULE

- 1) **Goodlatte (R-VA).** The amendment prohibits the use of eminent domain for the acquisition of tribal land under this act.
- 2) **Goodlatte (R-VA).** The amendment would amend the bill to only permit the Secretary of Interior to take into trust lands located in Amherst County into trust for the Monacan Indian Tribe.
