The RSC Repeal Task Force's mission is to put our nation onto a path of greater economic freedom by eliminating U.S. federal laws and regulations that impede or inhibit economic growth, prosperity, and opportunity. The Task Force is focused primarily on laws that are unconstitutional or run counter to free-market principles, limited government, or U.S. national security interests.

- Members will agree to champion the repeal of at least one federal law.
- For each championed repeal effort, Members will agree to take as many of these actions as possible:
 - ✓ Introduce a bill or amendment (in committee, if appropriate, as well as on the floor) to repeal the law;
 - ✓ Actively gather co-sponsors (if a stand-alone bill) or votes (as appropriate) for legislation;
 - ✓ Circulate at least one Dear Colleague on the legislation to all House offices;
 - ✓ Issue at least one press release on the legislation;
 - ✓ Place at least one op-ed on the legislation;
 - ✓ Speak on the House floor against the relevant law, either as part of a larger special order, or in a five- or one-minute speech;
 - ✓ Readily seek off-Hill support for the legislation;
 - ✓ Conduct research and provide other information in support of the federal law's repeal;
 - ✓ Pursue the introduction of Senate companion legislation.
